



3. Keep cheering respectful to allow all families and guests of other graduates to hear their graduates' names when they are read.


#### Social Media:

### **Accessibility Services**



- ✤ Wheelchair seating is located in the places indicated with blue stars.
- Use the East end entrances (football field side) to access the main floor handicap seating area (largest area).

- ✤ Facilities are located on the first floor only.
