



## Policy and Procedures Manual Application: All Personnel Section A6.8.1 Marijuana Policy

### A 6.8.1 Marijuana Policy

The use, possession, sale, or distribution of marijuana (including medical marijuana, edibles, and products containing marijuana) on any university owned or controlled property or at any university event remains illegal pursuant to the Controlled Substances Act, the Drug Free Schools and Communities Act, and the Drug Free Workplace Act, and against the Regional University System of Oklahoma (RUSO) policy.

You may not bring marijuana on any university property or to any university event, smoke or consume marijuana or any product containing marijuana on any university property or at any university event, and you may not come to class or work under the influence of any illegal substance including marijuana.

Even though medical marijuana is now legal under Oklahoma law, it remains illegal under federal law. As a recipient of federal funding, East Central University must abide by federal law which prohibits the unlawful manufacture, distribution, possession, and use of illegal drugs including medical marijuana.

Regardless of having a license for medical marijuana, its use on campus or at university events is strictly prohibited and violation of RUSO policy regarding controlled substances such as marijuana may result in disciplinary action up to and including and termination.
